Dear Resident Family Members and/or Representative:

Regarding: COVID-19

Please accept this letter as notification that amongst the COVID-19 tests that we have completed from 12/16/20 to the date of this letter on our staff and contract/outside providers we received **one positive** test result for one of our staff members. The staff member has been placed on furlough and will not be allowed to return to work until a negative COVID-19 test is obtained.

The visitor restrictions that were put into place on 12/11/20 will be extended through 12/30/20. No visits will be able to be held until 12/31/20. Date will be extended if further positive test results are received.

Our facility quarantine that was set to end on 12/23/20 is extended through 12/30/20. All staff was again tested this week and as long as all tests are negative, we may be able to end our quarantine the morning of 12/31/20. Per our guidelines received by the NYS Department of Health no communal dining or activities can be held during the quarantine and residents will continue to remain in their rooms per NYS DOH guidance that the facility must follow.

We will continue to monitor residents very closely with temperature and other vital checks every 4 hours. All residents of the facility that agree to be tested will be tested for COVID-19 at this time. Testing will continue to be completed on any resident that develops symptoms.

Staff will continue to wear full Personal Protective Equipment as needed when in contact with residents for personal care. All high touch areas of facility will continue to be sanitized on a frequent basis with increased sanitizing where needed.

You will be kept informed of results of further testing and next steps. Updates will continue to be posted on our website. <https://pineview.mysite-dev.com>.
